

## ITE – 2024 HONG KONG OUTBOUND REPORT

(Prepared on 11-Dec-2024)^

In the first 10 months of 2024, Hong Kong residents made 85.18 million departures which up 52% over same period last year, Hong Kong outbound to some Asian destinations in the first eight to ten months of 2024 also recorded growth, particularly, Hong Kong outbound to Japan in the first 8 months totalled 1.8 million, which already exceeded the pre-pandemic of 2019.

By international tourism expenditure, Hong Kong ranked Asia's 4<sup>th</sup> largest market in 2019, and its outbound in 2023 recovered to **84%** by **spending (US\$22.7 billion)** and **77%** by **departures (72.2 million)**, reflecting **quality recovery** with spending more recovered than departure. However, **outbound package tour recovery far slower than market**, which media, quoting industry source, reported in March 2024 (Oriental Daily 20/3/2024) recovered to **around half** pre-pandemic level!

The ITE Hong Kong 2024 Survey, which was held online during May-June 2024, collected 3740 replies, found ITE public visitors are mainly premium FIT: 90% traveling in private group / independently (non-package tour); 40% been / plan travel over 6 times and 60% to increase travel spending in 2024! ## **Hong Kong Related Market News on Travel Interests**

- → HSBC survey found Hong Kong Z generation on average made 3 outbound holidays in past year, and spent a total of HK\$35000 which some 13% of their income.
- HSBC Hong Kong reported its Travel Club Member Scheme, which launched in September last year, now has 260,000 members, who in the past year each on average booked 12 times air ticket or hotel and their overseas billing 60% higher than ordinary card holders.

- On ranking various major expenses during retirement, 82% Hong Kong investors pick "meeting daily expenses", 68% pick "medical emergency funding", and 63% pick "entertainment and travel", from above survey.
- In the period of 12 months from August 2023 to July 2024, Hong Kong International Airport handled 49.2 million passengers which doubled the year before, and 339,080 flights which grew 63.1%.
- ♣ In the first 9 months of 2024, Hong Kong Express which Cathay subsidiary flied 50% more flights than and carried 55% more passengers than same period last year. It projects carrying 6 million passengers by the end of this year and reported bookings for coming Christmas and Chinese New Year rose 30%.
