ITE Hong Kong and MICE Travel Expo 2025 selected as Hong Kong Mega Event

Please be informed ITE Hong Kong and MICE Travel Expo 2025 (ITE) have been selected as a Mega Event in Hong Kong and being listed on the official Mega Event calendar! Our honor! Such honor means more to us as an encouragement to go further than an endorsement! Also, in our view, such honor shall be shared with all individuals, organizations and companies who have been in one way or another supporting and/or participating in ITE in the long struggle to hold live editions during the pandemic years!

The tough environment in past years means recovery path been a haphazard one! Our first attempt failed in 2020, and the first live ITE was held in 2021. Since then live ITE been holding annually, and all post pandemic live editions have international exhibitors. In fact, ITE in 2023 started having back regional buyers and trade visitors; and in 2024 used same number of halls as in 2019, nearly half buyers and trade visitors from outside Hong Kong, and public visitors back to some 85% pre-pandemic level. Mega events can drive the business of multiple sectors, such as tourism, hotel, catering and retail, bringing huge economic benefits to Hong Kong. It is roughly estimated that every 1.5 million tourists can contribute to around 0.1 percentage point of growth in Gross Domestic Product.

Since the full resumption of normal travel in early 2023, many mega events have taken place in Hong Kong. They include Art Basel Hong Kong, Hong Kong Sevens, FIVB Volleyball Nations League, Hong Kong International Dragon Boat Races, Hong Kong Cyclothon, Hong Kong Wine & Dine Festival, Hong Kong
